What Do We Have to Offer?

Years ago I called the Rabbi of a local Jewish synagogue to ask if I could visit with him for about thirty minutes to ask questions about his religion. He agreed and we had a pleasant visit. He was a recent graduate of New York University.

During our discussion it became obvious that he not only rejected the inspiration of the New Testament, he also had serious doubts about the inspiration of the Old Testament. When I asked if he believed in heaven and hell, he responded, "I'm not sure. But if there is a heaven, all good people will go there." He summarized his religion this way: "Our religion revolves around celebrating holidays and burning candles."

I remember leaving our meeting feeling rather sad, thinking, "He doesn't have much to offer people."

That's been about 40 years ago . . . and I've thought about it regularly since. It causes me to ask myself, "What do we have to offer people?" That incident has served as a kind of compass to remind me where our focus needs to be. I'm convinced that it's good to have a variety of ministries which focus on the needs of specific ages and demographic groups (i.e. children, teens, singles, families, ladies'/men's groups, etc.). But fellowship won't get you to heaven. Being active in these groups won't get you to heaven.

Learning to trust God enough to make His will the center of your life will get you to heaven. Every ministry must be focused on that goal. Fun, food and fellowship is not enough.

Knowing God . . . learning His will . . . encouraging each other to focus on these goals—that's what we have to offer. Let's be as effective toward that goal as we possibly can be.
