Don't Grab a Dog's Ears!

Have you ever allowed yourself to become involved in a situation and wished you could get out of it, but realize there is no easy way out?

One reason I love the book of Proverbs is because it teaches basic principles that are applicable to every situation in life . . . if we will allow ourselves to be taught (and that's a big "if").

Regarding such a situation described above, listen to these wise principles:

First—A warning to recognize and stay away from such situations:

“Like one who seizes a dog by the ears is a passerby who meddles in a quarrel not his own,” (Proverbs 26:17). It's not hard to understand this scenario, right? Grabbing a vicious dog by the ears only increases the problem. Now, how do you let go?

Second—How do I get out of this mess?

But now you are in this situation (whatever it may be), what do you do? Proverbs 6:1-5 (NLT) gives another scenario—about foolishly co-signing for a loan for someone else. It says, “Now swallow your pride; go and beg to have your name erased. Don't put it off; do it now!” Some problems we foolishly get ourselves into only grow more complex and costly with time, but our pride won't let us do what is necessary to get out!

The Take Away—Pick your fights!

You don't have to get involved in every cause that someone brings you. We have a classic example in Luke 12:13-14—“Someone in the crowd said to [Jesus], ‘Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me.’ Jesus replied, ‘Man, who appointed me a judge or arbiter between you?’”

You don't have to get involved in every fight.
