Righteousness or Love

It occurs to me that there are two overriding principles in the Bible that summarize and incorporate all the others; two things that we need to keep as our central focus -God's righteousness and God's love. All the great doctrines fit under one or the other of these two umbrella truths. These principles define God's character.

The doctrinal truths of law, judgement, guilt, and punishment are related to God's righteousness. Mercy, grace, justification, Gospel, redemption . . . all these great truths are the result of God's love.

But interestingly, God's righteousness and God's love are polar opposites. They can't both stay in the same bucket. Law (representing righteousness) and grace (representing love) are mutually exclusive. Law contains no grace; grace sets law aside.

To highjack a phrase – "Law is law and grace is grace and never the twain shall meet." . . . except they did - on the cross. God's righteousness and God's love were reconciled. And incredibly, law, judgement, guilt, sin, and punishment were not set aside; they were not ignored. The demands of God's righteousness were fulfilled and satisfied.

Only when those demands were satisfied could God extend his grace to guilty sinners. At the cross righteousness and love met . . . and they shook hands.

To understand the Gospel, we must understand sin and guilt. To be converted, we must first be convicted of sin. Otherwise the Gospel is not really good news – it's cheap grace. Cheap grace doesn't lead to gratitude or a sense of responsibility and commitment. If it comes too easy, it goes just as easily.

God is righteous and God is love. I'm glad he's both. As Christians we can now benefit from both.
