"Do Not Be Ashamed of Me and My Words"

Have you heard about the family that became fed up with life in the big city?

They decided to move to Texas and try their hands at living in the wide -open spaces. Intending to raise beef cattle, the family purchased a large ranch. About a month later, some friends came to visit and inquired as to what they had named the ranch.

The husband said, "Well, I was partial to the 'Flying-W.' My wife wanted to call it the 'Suzie-Q.' One of our sons liked the 'Bar-J' and the other suggested the 'Lazy-Y Ranch.' So we compromised and now we call it The Flying-W, Suzie-Q, Bar-J, Lazy-Y Ranch." A bit later, one of the friends asked, "Where are all of your cattle?" The man replied, "Uhh... we don't have any. None of 'em survived the brandin'!"

The moral of the story is – Some things should never be compromised!

Most folks don't have much of a sense of direction in their life. They're just waiting for the next bandwagon to come along so they can jump on. Go with the flow. See which direction the wind is blowing and go with it. Go along to get along.

When Jesus said, "What does it profit a man if he gains the whole world but lose his own soul?" he must have been thinking about folks who compromise the vital truth principles that guide our lives. In that context (Mark 8:36) he was speaking about people who are ". . . ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation . . .". So it's not a new thing for some to compromise truth principles in order to get along with current society.

To be sure, there are some things on which we can and should compromise - things that are not a basis of Christian faith. We need to pray for wisdom to know what those principles are. And when we know, we must be willing to stand alone if necessary.

Henry Clay, when running for the office of President, was told that his abolitionist position would likely cost him the presidency replied, "I would rather be right than President."

Each one of us need to sort out what's worth dying for. When we get that figured out, we will know what to live for. We'll know what's important and what's not so important . . . what we can compromise and what we can't compromise.

"Father, please give us the wisdom to know what we can compromise and what we cannot. And give us the humility to compromise when we can and the courage to stand when we cannot."
