### This, Too, Shall Pass

When you are in a stressful situation, is there anything that provides you comfort or consolation? I'll share one of mine with you. "This too shall pass." I'm sure that many of you, like me, heard these words from your parents when you were struggling with some situation.

Some folks think this is a biblical quote. It's not. No one knows its origin. Earliest records find the quote in both Persian and early Jewish writings. It was quoted by Abraham Lincoln in 1859. He attributed its origin to an "Eastern monarch who charged his wise men to invent him a sentence . . . which should be true and appropriate in all times and situations. They presented to him the words, 'And this, too, shall pass away.'"

While my application of this adage has been almost exclusively to combat discouragement during difficult times, this sword has another edge. It also reminds us that times of health, peace and prosperity are fleeting.

That leads me to the Bible verse that reflects the message expressed by this quote—II Corinthians 4:18—" . . . For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal." Jesus reminded us of the temporary nature of everything physical when he said, "Heaven and earth will pass away . . ."

So let's be reminded that every person—no matter how powerful they may be, and every worldly agenda—no matter how influential it may seem . . . will soon change.

Be consoled by this reality, but also be reminded—this world is not my home. I want to invest my life (time, energy, resources, talents and emotions) in something/somewhere that's not going to pass away!

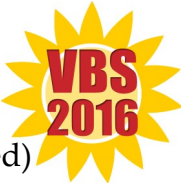
