ARE YOU ON THE SIDE OF TRUTH?

When Jesus was on trial before the Roman governor Pilate, at the conclusion of the interrogation, Jesus told him, "Everyone who is on the side of the truth listens to me."

That's the watershed issue for every individual . . . for every society. Are you on the side of truth?

Pilate's response is characteristic of those who do not acknowledge that there is such a thing as "the truth." He said, "What is truth?"

Refusal to acknowledge that truth exists allows us to create our own truth.

Paul spoke of those who were ". . . always learning but never able to acknowledge the truth." Such persons may be considered the "intellectuals" of their time. How many successful careers are built on lies, compromise and other forms of manipulating the truth?

Being on the side of truth is often extremely costly. Refusal to compromise truth may cost you your job. It has cost many Christians their lives.

Lies enslave people. Buying into lies sets your life on a course—a course that leads farther and farther away from God. Eve believed a lie.

Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

The value you place on truth determines the course of your life. It determines how your life will end. It determines your eternal destiny.


