See if this accurately rephrases I John 4:20- "If you don't love your brother, you don't love God."

### Jesus, Yes; Church, No

"If anyone says 'I love God,' yet hates his brother, he is a *liar.*" – 1 John 4:20

There are varying levels of application of this truth. There is the obvious application - which I would assume requires little explanation. Then there are applications which may be less obvious on the surface. I would suggest that one such applications can be found in the sentiment "Jesus yes; church no."

Think about it. Isn't that simply a subtle way of saying, "I love God, but I don't want to have to deal with Christians?" When we manifest this attitude, we usually continue our reasoning by trying to justify it by talking about how hypocritical Christians are. We convince ourselves that we are superior to them.

Do you suppose that Jesus was aware of the hypocrisy of religious people of his day? But ... He still came!

I think it's much easier to claim to love God than it is to claim to love our neighbors. It's easier to measure vour love for someone vou can see than it is someone you can't see. You can give the appearance of loving God by keeping your hands clean; but if you love your brother you have to get your hands dirty.

Too many of us have created our own personal God that can be pleased pretty easily – a few dollars and an hour or two per week. But we don't have time to mess with needy brothers and sisters.

And maybe we justify our own hypocrisy by saying "I don't really hate anyone." But know that the Bible often uses the word hate to indicate "low value."
