MY RESPONSE TO PRO-ABORTIONISTS' CRITICISM

One of the most frequently used tactics of pro-abortionists in their attempt to discredit those who fight for the lives of the unborn is that "pro-lifers have no concern for the welfare of the mother and no concern for the welfare of the child once it is born."

Hitler wrote in Mein Kampf regarding how to effectively persuade the masses, "It [propaganda] must confine itself to a few points and repeat them over and over." He cared very little if his propaganda was truthful or a lie. The only criterion was—is it effective? Abortion proponents have used this lie repeatedly. I would like to offer a brief rebuttal.

Here are a few things that Woodland Oaks church of Christ does to help these children once they are born:

- We have multiple families who have/are in the process of adopting "unwanted children." For the record, and contrary to accusations otherwise, the majority of those children are not blue-eyed, pink-skinned, problem-free babies!
- We have adoptive parents who have founded an orphanage in an Asian country. This orphanage is supported by private funds from Christians. It accepts no government funds. It currently provides a home for 40 orphans.
- This congregation sends a significant amount of funds to an orphanage in Peru which provides for over 600 orphans. It accepts no government funds.
- Not only does this church help fund these orphanages, numerous members travel—at their own expense—multiple times per year to be with these children.
- We collect food and contribute monthly to five orphanages in the states. Our youth frequently spend summer vacation time serving at these orphanages.

Regarding the accusation that we do not care about the plight of women who find themselves pregnant and are unable to cope:

- More than 30 of our members recently attended (and generously contributed to) a fund-raising event to assist women in this area who find themselves in a "crisis pregnancy."
- Annually we distribute baby bottles to members who generously fill them with cash and checks to purchase needed supplies for pregnant women and these babies who need help.
- We also maintain a food pantry and a portion of our church's financial budget to assist families in difficult times.

That's part of what we "pro-lifers" do to help women and children and families. Now, I would like to ask you who are making this accusation, "What are you doing?"

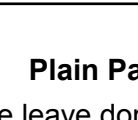
