Lest We Forget

Tomorrow is Memorial Day. A day designated to remember those who have died fighting for our freedom. The further we get from having experienced war the less meaningful it becomes. But veterans remember. Those who lost a husband, father, or brother remember. Tradition calls for the flag to be lowered to half-mast until noon then raised until sundown. It also calls for every American to pause at 3:00 p.m. for a moment of remembrance and gratitude.

Let's understand that while we can certainly apply the truthfulness of these words to our nation today, these words more accurately apply to the church. While our memorial to those who fought and died for our country certainly should and does have a place deep in our hearts, even deeper and more precious to us is our memorial of the one who died to set us free to live with him for eternity.

Jesus originated a memorial so that we will never forget – "As often as you drink it (blood of grapes – representing His blood), do this in remembrance of me."

Lest we forget . . . today is Memorial Day!
