If we do not submit to the same standard . . . the same authority, we will always be divided. If we don't honor the same rules, conflict is inevitable. And if tolerance means that I must agree with you, rather than being able to agree to disagree without conflict, then the only way that peace is possible is if one of us persuades the other to change our standard of authority.

It never has.

Admittedly, there are things that I do not understand. But that's not always the reason for conflict. Sometimes, I understand quite well . . . and I still disagree! But I don't hate you. I still love you.
