# What Does the Holy Spirit Do for Me?

Most Christians have an ongoing desire to understand more fully the role God's Holy Spirit plays in our lives. The New Testament epistles have a great deal to say about the Holy Spirit and what He does for us.

As we are learning more and more about **WHAT** the Spirit does for us, we need to focus on **HOW** we access the benefits available to us. Even if we never completely understand all He does for us, we can benefit from the things we don't understand (i.e. interceding to God on our behalf when we struggle in prayer - Romans 8:26-27) if we follow God's instructions about how we tap into this resource.

The way we access the benefits of the Holy Spirit's resources in our life is by "being led by the Spirit; walking in step with the Spirit; living according to the Spirit; being controlled by the Spirit." These and other phrases are used to contrast with a life that is "controlled by the flesh."

So, there is flesh and there is the Spirit. They are in conflict. You cannot successfully please both. "Those controlled by the flesh cannot please God." - Romans 8:8 This conflict is real. Every Christian has felt/feels it. Paul describes it beautifully in Romans 7. In his description, he uses the phrase "for I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out." I can relate to that, can't you? In Galatians 5, Paul says it again – "(Re: Spirit and flesh) – They are in conflict with each other, so that you cannot do what you want."

Among the many things that God's Holy Spirit does in our lives that we cannot do on our own is (1) put to death sinful habits in our lives, and (2) produce fruit in our lives that bring peace and security.

So, one way to understand **WHAT** the Holy Spirit does for us is – He enables us to do the things we want to do but cannot. If we walk according to the Spirit, He enables us to stop doing things we know are sinful and live a life filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and selfcontrol. - Galatians 5:19-25.
