Good Choices Make A Good Life

Every single decision you make has consequences. Usually we only think of poor decisions as having consequences.

Those "consequences" ARE YOUR LIFE! Your life is the result of the sum total of decisions you make.

You see people every day who have made some very poor decisions earlier in their life and now they are living the consequences. On the other hand, you also know some people who have made some very wise decisions in their life and they, too, are living the consequences.

Unfortunately, we may be unaware of the consequences of certain actions. Or we may choose to be ignorant of the consequences.

Usually, people who have to live with the consequences of poor decisions want to talk about their "bad luck." They also see others – whose life seems to be much better than their own – as having "good luck." They still haven't learned about decisions and consequences... or maybe they don't want to, because then they would have to accept the responsibility for their own situation. Some folks like being a victim because that means, "It's not my fault."

I'm not saying that everyone deserves everything that happens to them – good or bad. It "rains on the just and the unjust" (blessings); it is also true that "into each life a little rain must fall" (struggles). Bad things DO happen to good people; but good things also happen to bad people!

However, we can "tilt the balances" strongly in our favor by consistently making good, wise decisions. And we can guarantee the ultimate outcome.

Very early in human history God gave Cain some advice about decisions and consequences – *"If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must master it."*

Cain rejected God's advice. He lived ... and died... with the consequences!

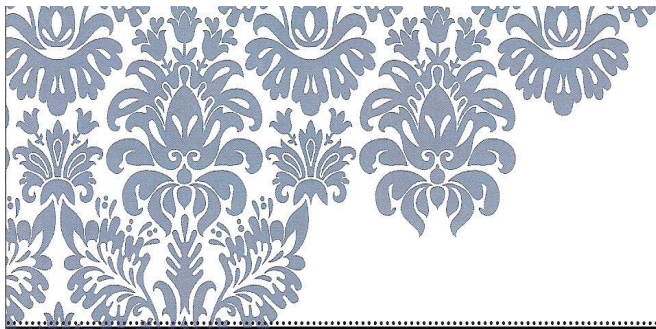

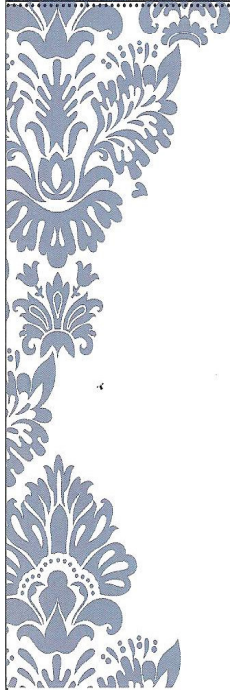

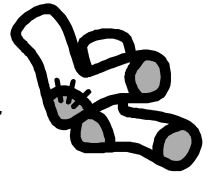
Summer Softball Starts Tomorrow

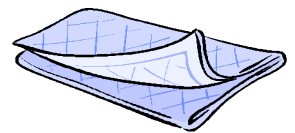


IT'S TIME TO THINK PERU!!!!
