I love the details in this picture. The podium and microphone are drawn fairly accurate. The cord to the microphone did run outside the podium to where it was plugged in. My Bible is always open when I preach. The neck of the microphone did have those lines so it could bend. But there are some details that are NOT accurate. Unlike the picture, I do have a nose. I also have ears. My hands don't look like small clouds

in real life, and I've never worn a tie with a short sleeve shirt. Not everything is accurate or drawn to scale, but Elle put on paper what her eyes saw, and her mind told her 8-year-old hand to draw.

I love this picture. I keep this picture in my Bible and other things like it for a few reasons.

- 1. Elle has always enjoyed art. I look at this picture and see how she has progressed in her skill, and it's impressive. Maybe I should ask for an updated picture next time she's in town.
- 2. This picture reminds me of great memories from the past when my kids were younger. It's fun to come across this picture and relive those memories.
- 3. Most importantly, this picture reminds me that our kids are always watching me.

Last Sunday, I mentioned how parents and grandparents are the biggest, strongest, and longest lasting influence in our children's lives. This picture reminds me of that influence and keeps me on my toes so I will always work to be a godly influence. Paul wrote to the Philippian Christians and said, "What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me—practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you" (Phil. 4:9). I hope I have been that kind of example to my children.
