"Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light" (Matthew 11:28-30).

The Lord Jesus said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin" (John 8:34). Thankfully the Lord has a solution! "So if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed" (John 8:36). The Lord sets us free through His blood and the gospel.

The solution to our broken world is Jesus! Thomas O. Chism wrote: "Bring Christ your broken life, so marred by sin. He will create anew, make whole again. Your empty wasted years He will restore, and your iniquities remember no more."
