Annual State of the Bible

For the last 14 years, the American Bible Society has reported on the State of the Bible by investigating American's relationship with God, faith, and the Bible. The report highlights some key trends such as Scripture Engagement among Americans. The report is somewhat of a commentary on the spiritual state of America. For example:

- In 2020, 71 million American's were considered Scripture Engaged1.
- In 2024, that number fell to 47 million.

Bible Users are put into 4 categories: Ailing, Unhealthy, Healthy, and Thriving. Bible Users are put in these categories based on a Spiritual Vitality Gauge, which is composed of 9 questions about people's beliefs, spiritual practices, and faith in action. Again, I can't find these questions. Here are American Bible User's motivations for reading their Bibles in 2024.

- 42% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because it brings them closer to God.
- 18% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because it helps them discern God's will for their lives.
- 13% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because they need wisdom for making life decisions.
- 10% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because they need comfort.
- 9% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because it tells them about the nature of God.
- 4% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because it shows them how to treat others.
- 3% of all Bible Users, use the Bible because they know they are supposed to.

Now here's the kicker! A Bible User is defined as an individual who reads, listens to, or prays with the Bible on their own at least 3-4 times a year, outside of a church service or church event. I realize there are people who read way more than 3-4 times a year, but that's an absurd definition of a Bible User. No one would consider me a runner if I only ran 3-4 times a year, nor would it be of any benefit. Using the Bible 3-4 times a year will not help anyone gain a better understanding of the LORD, His character, or His will for their lives.

The importance of daily Bible engagement is seen in Psalm 119:97-14.

"Oh how I love your law! It is my meditation all the day. Your commandment makes me wiser than my enemies, for it is ever with me. I have more understanding than all my teachers, for your testimonies are my meditation. I understand more than the aged, for I keep your precepts. I hold back my feet from every evil way, in order to keep your word. I do not turn aside from your rules, for you have taught me. How sweet are your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth! Through your precepts I get understanding; therefore I hate every false way."

It's vitally important to your relationship with the LORD to be in His word every day and to put into practice what the Bible says.

¹The Scripture Engagement formula weighs responses to fifteen questions in three areas: Frequency of Bible reading; Impact on one's relationship with God and others; and Centrality of the Bible in decision-making. I could not find a copy of the 15 questions.
