### Shepherds Have A Huge Responsibility

It is my opinion that the office of a shepherd (elder/overseer/bishop) in the LORD's church is the highest responsibility this side of Heaven. Paul wrote to Timothy, "The saying is trustworthy: If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task" (1 Tim. 3:1). Paul says a shepherd must be above reproach (1 Tim. 3:2), and "care for the Church of God, which He obtained with His own blood" (Acts 20:28). Here are a few reasons why shepherding God's people is a HUGE responsibility.

- 1. Shepherds look after God's prized possession. Paul told the Ephesian elders, "Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood. I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. Therefore, be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish every one with tears" (Acts 20:28-31). Jesus bought the Church with His own blood and has left her in the care of local shepherds who are spiritually minded.
- 2. Shepherds are subject to the Chief Shepherd. Peter reminds shepherds they have a shepherd too, and when He returns, they will receive the unfading crown of glory if they have been faithful examples to the flock. "Shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory" (1 Peter. 5:2-4).
- **3. Judgment will begin at the household of God.** Peter wrote, "For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of God; and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God" (1 Peter 4:17)? God's judgment will begin with the very place that elders are entrusted to oversee, even further suggesting the depth of their responsibility.

We have a responsibility towards our shepherds. Hebrews 13:17 says, "Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you." We need to take these inspired words to heart in the same way that we want our shepherds to be serious towards the role the LORD has given them.
