Tassels On Your Heart

"The LORD said to Moses, 'Speak to the people of Israel, and tell them to make tassels on the corners of their garments throughout their generations, and to put a cord of blue on the tassel of each corner. And it shall be a tassel for you to look at and remember all the commandments of the LORD, to do them, not to follow after your own heart and your own eyes, which you are inclined to whore after. So you shall remember and do all my commandments, and be holy to your God. I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt to be your God: I am the LORD your God'" (Numbers 15:37-41).

The Israelites were instructed to make tassels with a blue cord and attach them to the corners of their garments. When an Israelite saw the tassel and blue cord during his/her day, they would be reminded of all the LORD's commandments and His holiness. So simple and helpful. This instruction comes directly after a man was stoned for not remembering the LORD's commands and violating the Sabbath. I imagine Israel was very thankful for the tassel reminder. Back to the purpose of the tassel. The tassel would be a reminder of the LORD's commandments and a reminder to DO them so they would be holy to the LORD. It was a reminder that YHWH was their God and He brought them out of Egypt. But there was another reason for the tassel. There was a negative reminder. The tassel reminded them to NOT follow their own heart and their own eyes which they were inclined to whore after. There was a reminder to do the right thing and not do the wrong thing. The purpose of the tassel was to keep the LORD and His holiness on the minds of His people.

There are so many things in the day that distract us from the LORD and His purpose for us. It's so easy to get busy in things of the day that the LORD's will and purpose can be pushed out of our minds. When the LORD and His commandments are pushed to the side of our minds, it's natural to pursue our self-interests. That's why Jesus says, "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you" (Matt. 6:33).
