Consider a few things the Bible says about friendship.

- “Faithful are the wounds of a friend; profuse are the kisses of an enemy” (Prov. 27:6).
- “Oil and perfume make the heart glad, and the sweetness of a friend comes from his earnest counsel” (Prov. 27:9).
- “Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another” (Prov. 27:17).
- “Bear one another’s burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ” (Gal. 6:2).
- “Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you” (Eph. 4:32).
- “For I have derived much joy and comfort from your love, my brother, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed through you” (Philemon 1:7).

Not all these verses are in the context of friendship, but I certainly think they have application. There is so much joy, comfort, encouragement, and refreshment that comes from spending time with Christian friends who love the LORD. Are you that kind of friend to others?
