Being a Christian has mands, but our salvation is not a transaction with God. We ey, not because of compulsion, but because we love Him who st loved us (1 John 4:16-21; 5:2-3). We have died with Him d now we must live with Him (Rom 6:8). The price has been id, so we must glorify God with our body (1 Cor 6:20).
