When Jesus was tempted, He answered the devil, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matt. 4:4). The word of God is our spiritual food. It's necessary to our spiritual health just like physical food is to our body. The word of God feeds and grows our spiritual lives, and keeps us spiritually healthy.

Paul wrote to Timothy and reminded him, "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work" (2 Tim. 3:16,17).

Paul says the Scriptures are beneficial and useful for four things:

- Teaching The Bible is the comprehensive body of truth for right living with God.
- Reproof The Bible reveals what is sin.
- Correction The Bible reveals how to deal with sin.
- Training in righteousness The Bible will help you grow in your faith.

Summed up, The Bible tells us what is right, it tells us what isn't right, it tells us how to get right, and tells us how to stay right. The result? You will be equipped (properly outfitted) for every good work of God.

If you've stopped spending time in God's word, it's never too late to get back into the groove of reading. Set aside 10 minutes a day to read and then spend a few minutes in prayer. Your life will be blessed, and you will begin to enjoy and look forward to your time with the LORD.
