GOD'S LOVE FOR HIS CHILDREN

"Jesus loves me, this I KNOW." God loves all humanity and there is a sense in which all who are on the earth are His children as His creation (Ps. 8:3-8; Acts 17:28-29). Yet, the ones who call on Him as Father, through Jesus Christ, truly are His children (cf. Jn. 1:12; Acts 2:21, 38; Eph. 1:5; 5:1-8). How do I know Jesus loves me? Look at ways the Bible tells me so: God's nature is evidence of His love for His children. "God is love" (1 Jn. 4:8). "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning" (Jas. 1:17). The changeless nature of God shows He loves us and will always love us. He will always be a source of constant strength, stability, wisdom, and love. "Yes, Jesus loves me."

God's physical provisions are evidence of His love for His children. God created the world "very good." He provides for His creation, and He will provide for us! In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus gives points to the birds and grass to materially worried people. Jesus concluded, "seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you" (Matt. 6:25-34). "Yes, Jesus loves me."

God's instruction is evidence of His love for His children. One man said, "Rules without relationship equals rebellion, but relationship without rules equals chaos." Many parents know the pain and sorrow of both extremes. God in His great love for us did not leave us without a moral guide, but the Bible, is His word to His children to know Him and who He wants us to be (Eph. 5:1, 8). "Yes, Jesus loves me."

God's chastening is evidence of His love for His children. "If you endure chastening, God deals with you as sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten" (Heb. 12:7)? Chastening and discipline demonstrate love. God chastens us "for our profit that we may be partakers of His holiness" (Heb. 12:10). God wants the "peaceable fruit of righteousness" to grow in our lives, and therefore He disciplines us as His children. How deep the Father's love for us! "Yes, Jesus loves me."

God's Sacrifice is evidence of His love for His children. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (Jn. 3:16). The greatest evidence of God's love for us is in Jesus Christ and His death on the cross for our sins. We should have a profound appreciation for the "width and length and depth and height" of the love of Christ which "passes knowledge" (Eph. 3:18-19). "Yes, Jesus loves me, the Bible tells me so."
