Wash Away Your Sins

Below are 11 verses about baptism found in the New Testament. I don't have room to provide the immediate context for these verses, which would lend a better understanding to what the Holy Spirit is revealing. Please read these verses and then I will ask a question.

"Whoever believes and is **baptized** will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned" (Mark 16:16).

"Repent and be **baptized** every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38).

"But when they believed Philip as he preached good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized**, both men and women" (Acts 8:12).

"And he commanded them to be **baptized** in the name of Jesus Christ" (Acts 10:48).

"And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their wounds; and he was **baptized** at once, he and all his family" (Acts 16:33).

"And now why do you wait? Rise and be **baptized** and wash away your sins, calling on his name" (Acts 22:16).

"Do you not know that all of us who have been **baptized** into Christ Jesus were **baptized** into his death" (Rom. 6:3)?

"We were buried therefore with him by **baptism** into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life" (Rom. 6:4).

"For in one Spirit we were all **baptized** into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit" (1 Cor. 12:13).

"For as many of you as were **baptized** into Christ have put on Christ" (Gal. 3:27).

"Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ" (1 Pet. 3:21).

If an honest person with little to no knowledge of baptism were to read these verses in context, what would they believe about baptism? Would they believe baptism was a way to earn salvation? Would they believe baptism was necessary to be forgiven by God? Would they believe a person should be baptism but doesn't need to be baptized? Today and next Sunday we are going to do our best to be honest with the Scripture and let the Bible speak for itself about baptism.
