Except You Repent . . .

The basic key to a relationship with God is repentance. Without repentance you cannot walk with God. God doesn't change his pattern of thinking so that he can walk with you. You don't know the path to eternal life. He does. You don't know how to make your marriage work. He does. You don't know how to rear godly children. He does.

Jeremiah knew what we need to know about how to walk with God. He verbalized it this way—"I know, O Lord, that a man's life is not his own; it is not for man to direct his steps," (Jeremiah 10:23).

Here is our fundamental problem that keeps us from submitting to God (his instruction and discipline)—we absolutely believe that my life is my own! We have never questioned that belief. We live our life and make every decision based on that conviction. So we feel no need to repent!

John's message was "Repent." Jesus' message was "Repent," (Matthew 3:2; 4:17). It doesn't matter who you are, every relationship with God begins and is maintained by repentance.

Repentance means "to change your mind." The only reason someone would refuse to repent is that we either do not know God's way or we think our way is better than his.

We are in a series of lessons from Ephesians 5-6 teaching us that every Christian submits. We submit in a marriage relationship, in a family relationship, to government authority and in the church.

Our human nature (pride) and the world tell us we don't need to repent and we don't need to submit.

The question then is, "Do you know better than God knows?"
