A Word To Parents

Today is Father’s Day, and just a few weeks ago was Mother’s Day. The Bible doesn’t say a whole lot about parents, but the wisdom of God is certainly seen in the family and how God structured the family unit.

- “*Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you*” (Ex. 20;12).
- “*Honor your father and mother*” (*this is the first commandment with a promise*)” (Eph. 6:2).
- “*Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it*” (Prov. 22:6).

God expects parents to know Him and His will and pass that knowledge on to their children, so they will know God and His will. The goal is for each generation to know, love, and follow the LORD. The goal is accomplished when parents who love the LORD teach and show their children to love the LORD. But when parents fail to teach and show their children how to love the LORD, the Bible shows us the next generation simply forgets and abandons the LORD (Judges 2). There must be active teaching and showing.

Parents have a grave responsibility in living up to the LORD’s expectations for them. Under the Law of Moses, parents had clear instruction. “*Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates*” (Deut. 6:4-9).

The Deut. 6 sentiment is repeated in the NT.

- “*Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord*” (Eph. 6:4).
- “*I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, dwells in you as well*” (2 Tim. 1:5).
- “*... how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus*” (2 Tim. 3:15).

Parents, strive to love the LORD and teach your children to do the same.
