Jesus’ Purpose

In the gospels Jesus makes several purpose statements that reveal to us why He came into the world. These statements were our topics of study in Bible class at Camp Blue Haven this year. They gave us some great opportunities to open up the Bible, discuss the work of Jesus, and make application to the lives of 20 high school students.

- *“For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me. And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day”* (John 6:38-40).
- *“Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. For truly, I say to you, until heaven and earth pass away, not an iota, not a dot, will pass from the Law until all is accomplished”* (Matt. 5:17,18).
- *“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor”* (Luke 4:18,19)
- *“For judgment I came into this world, that those who do not see may see, and those who see may become blind”* (John 9:39).
- *“For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost”* (Luke 19:10).
- *“Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I have not come to bring peace, but a sword”* (Matthew 10:34).
- *“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many”* (Mark 10:45).
- *“The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly”* (John 10:10).
